PUBLIC NOTICE
COVID-19 RESPONSE

After receiving updates & input from Governor Stitt's office on 3/18/20 the Town of Langley will be implementing the following guidelines. While there are no cases known in Mayes County or the surrounding area at this time, we are trying to be proactive instead of reactive.

Restaurants, bars and other privately-owned gathering places are highly encouraged to limit the number of patrons such that at least six feet of space is available to each person. Such facilities are further encouraged to provide "take out" options.

In-person gatherings for social, spiritual and recreational purposes including, but not limited to, community, civic, public, leisure, faith-based or sporting events, parades, concerts, festivals, conventions, fundraisers and similar activities are strongly discouraged.

Effective 3/18/20 at 5:00 P.M. All City Offices, Public Library, Water Offices will be close to the public until further notice. Employees will remain in the office to answer phones at this time.

We strongly encourage our customers to utilize the following payment methods, online payment www.langleyok.org, pay by phone 918-782-2776, or use our drop box for payments at this time. There is a fee associated with online transactions charged by our vendor of .75 and 2.75% for debit or credit cards & 1.25 for checks. During this time, we plan to credit the transaction fee back to your account on the next business day.

Water shut offs will be suspended at this time.

Public gatherings will not be allowed at any City owned or managed facility at this time.

Langley Municipal Court has been canceled until further notice. You may call 918-782-9850 and make payments by phone. We're currently waiving the convenience fee for phone payments until further notice.
